Scott Robertson, U.S. Navy

Rear Admiral Robertson is the Director of Strategy, Policy and Plans (J5) North Aerospace American Defense Command and United States Northern Command, Peterson Space



Force Base in Colorado Springs, Colorado.

He is a third-generation naval officer. As an enlisted Seaman in 1986, he attended the Navy's Broadened Opportunity for Officer Selection and Training (BOOST) program earning a four-year NROTC scholarship at Norwich University where he earned a commission, and a Bachelor's in Mechanical Engineering in 1991. He later earned a Master of Science in Systems Engineering from George Mason University.

As a Surface Warfare Officer, Rear Adm. Robertson has served in a highly diverse and extensive range of assignments onboard cruisers, aircraft carriers and frigates. He commanded frigate, USS Rodney M. Davis (FFG 60) during a seven-month counter-narcotic deployment. He then commanded cruiser, USS Normandy (CG 60) the first Aegis Baseline 9 warship with naval Integrated Fire Control - Counter Air capability and took her on a nine-month globalcircumnavigation deployment where he served as the Air and Missile defense commander for the USS Theodore Roosevelt Carrier Strike Group.

Robertson's shore assignments include Aegis Training and Readiness Center Air Defense Instructor, Joint Staff (J8) Directorate as the resources and acquisition manager, and Commanding Officer of Surface Warfare Officers School Command.

Rear Adm. Robertson's initial Flag Officer Assignments were as Commander Naval Surface and Mine Warfare Development Center followed by his assumption of duties as Commander, Carrier Strike Group TWO as lead of the USS Dwight D. Eisenhower Carrier Strike Group deploying for seven months to the European and Central Command areas of responsibility. In July 2022 he reported to his current assignment at NORAD and NORTHCOM.
